**ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

The matter is before me on the parties' **Stipulation for Dismissal** [#26]<sup>1</sup> filed March 30, 2016. After careful review of the stipulation and the file, I conclude that the stipulation should be approved and that this action should be dismissed with prejudice.
