6. Accordingly, Plaintiff, with Defendants' consent, now asks this Court to grant a ten (10) business day extension of time through and including March 10, 2008, to respond to Defendants' Motion to Dismiss.

7. This motion is filed in good faith and not for the purposes of delay.

8. Granting this motion will not prejudice any of the parties to this action.

9. Plaintiff contacted counsel for Defendants regarding this motion and Defendants have consented to this extension.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff, Jose Ernesto Martinez, respectfully requests this Court enter an Order Granting Plaintiff a ten (10) business day extension of time to respond to Defendants' Motion to Dismiss up to and including March 10, 2008, and for such other relief as it deems necessary, just and proper.
