**DECLARATION OF JEFFREY NORBERG IN SUPPORT OF DEFENDANT
FACEBOOK, INC.’S MOTION FOR LEAVE TO AMEND ITS RESPONSIVE
PLEADING TO ADD A COUNTERCLAIM OF FALSE MARKING**

I, Jeffrey Norberg, declare:

1. I am an attorney with Cooley Godward Kronish LLP, of counsel in this action for defendant Facebook, Inc. I make this declaration in support of Facebook’s Motion for Leave to Amend its Responsive Pleading to Add a Counterclaim of False Marking. 
