
**Re: Leader Technologies, Inc. v. Facebook, Inc., Civ. No. 08-862-JJF-LPS**

In an effort to simplify the Court's task in reviewing our Opening Statement demonstratives, Facebook has revised the original PowerPoint that the Court received at the Final Pre-Trial Conference this morning to remove the allegedly "argumentative" content identified by Leader. Additionally, pending the Court's ruling on Facebook's motion to admit, Facebook has revised its timelines regarding offers for sale and public uses to include only those that were disclosed in Facebook's interrogatory response served on April 19, 2010 (Facebook's Fourth Supplemental Interrogatory Response to Interrogatory No. 4) pursuant to the Court's order.

We hope this now resolves any remaining concerns concerning the Opening Statement demonstratives.
