ORDER

And now this 3rd day of **February, 2011**, after having been advised by

Plaintiff and Defendants of their inability to resolve a discovery matter,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a teleconference is scheduled for **February 22, 2011 at 11:15 a.m.** Counsel for the party seeking relief shall initiate the teleconference call to **302-573-4573**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that not later than, **February 17, 2011 at 3:00 p.m.**, any party seeking relief shall file with the Court a letter, not to exceed three (3) pages, outlining the issues in dispute and its position on those issues. Not later than **February 18, 2011 at 3:00 p.m.**, any party opposing the application for relief may file a letter, not to exceed three (3) pages, outlining that party's reasons for its opposition. A copy of the document(s) must be provided to the Court within one (1) hour of e-filing the document(s). Should the Court find further briefing necessary upon conclusion of the telephone conference, the Court will order it.

Delaware counsel are reminded of their obligations to inform out-of-state counsel of this Order. To avoid the imposition of sanctions, counsel shall advise the Court immediately of any problems regarding compliance with this Order.
