Mark Sutherland Simpson Biography

Mark Sutherland Simpson is a translator, novelist and poet, a proud Francophile and New Yorker, and the former Upper School Principal at prestigious Trinity School in Manhattan. Amazon allows you to read the front, the back, the first 10-20 pages, and to follow tags to find the books most appropriate to your tastes. No bookstore ever has or ever will offer the array of books, the degree of choice, and the opportunity to examine the product as we can now in the digital world. Good riddance to the haughty publishing companies, bookstores with insipid employees, and arrogant agents ... and welcome to literature's brave new world of self-publishing.

Mark Sutherland Simpson Biography

I'm a fifth-generation Californian, raised in a big old house amid orange groves, summers at Laguna Beach and a cabin at Huntington Lake in the High Sierras. My grandfather helped build the road up the Sierras and my great great grandfather's name is on the cornerstone of several county courthouses, which he paid to have built. My Californian roots are deep and strong.

With a Ph.D. in Comparative Literature, and a career as an English teacher, I've spent my life reading like a rat chewing through wires ...relentlessly. Several years ago I began to detect changes in the publishing world, changes that pleased me. Amazon's capacity to allow me to read the first 10-20 pages of a novel, plus a "surprise me" button that took me into several pages of the book's interior, made me begin choosing what one might call off-beat novels (like the utterly brilliant *Shuck*, by Daniel Allen Cox). They weren't published by the old publishing houses, but often by upstarts or most often by the author himself/herself.

Thankfully, Jeff Bezos introduced streamlined self-publishing processes. They are amazing. Mind, you have to do your own writing of the novel and any marketing ... or not, as you wish. Readers (just like me) find their books online now, by typing in keywords and then browsing. I often start with a city as a keyword, and end up with something like Berlin gay historical. Don't be surprised when 10 books appear. I don't give a hoot about the publisher. With respect to the older publishing houses, I have read some absolutely terrible writing published in the mainstream (pitifully poor writing). I began a recent bestseller by one of the biggest names in old-fashioned publishing and had to stop, because the bumbling, simplistic plot and atrocious English was killing my literary sensitivities.

Now, I go to Amazon, keyword my choices, then I read the first 10-20 pages, take my mystery tour on "surprise me" and buy it if I like it. In this fashion, I have read more good books in the last several years than ever in my life. For me, self-publishing was a choice, and a great one. I have made enough money to live, and although I have a stalker (read above) who calls himself Samantha, gives me one star and calls my books "pure garbage," it hasn't slowed sales one iota. Why? Because people can read the beginnings of the novels for themselves, and see that they are ... modesty aside ... superb. So ...welcome to the twenty-first century! It's nice here.

C. Alcuin Becket Biography

First and foremost, let me say that I have been writing these novels over the last fifteen years. I'm a shy guy, and it's taken me this long to publish them. I did not want anyone to think I wrote five novels in one month! I didn't. They are the fruits of many, many years of hard labor. My newest novel is *An Oily Glint*, a novel about family guilt following a little boy's drowning.

Born and raised in Montana, I'm a child of Big Sky Country and proud of it. Although I left my home at 18 to go off to college, I return every summer to the place that moves me most deeply: Montana. I own a lovely old house in Helena, which my Aunties have helped me restore, but which my Aunt Lois's Golden Labrador (Norton, by name) think is HIS house.

I came to literature early in life, as well as my sexuality. The first I did much with, the second I kept a secret for a long while. In the end, of course, I realized as people often do that my parents and all of my Aunts, Uncles, Cousins and friends had guessed it years ago, and couldn't care less. Montanans are, generally speaking, a live and let live culture.

Within literature I found life's many meanings, outside of my religious upbringing as an Episcopalian. I was my class Valedictorian and had many offers for college. I chose to go East, rather than West, and have never regretted it. I'm actually a non-practicing attorney now, who works full-time for a non-profit organization. I write at nights and on the weekends. My life is pretty much an open book, and I'm glad you're here to share it with me.

Mark Sutherland Simpson is a proud New Yorker, with an equal love for France, French and his apartment in Paris. His writing has been raising eyebrows for the last several years, including having sold the rights for at least one major film, and now lauded on several continents.

Toward that end, I respect parts of many cultures and some religions, but only because they have earned them."

Writing is my way of holding my personal magnifying glass over the world and then, in the fashion of Emile Zola, writing what I see and feel; or perhaps sometimes in the fashion of an angry Jessica Mitford or Dorothy Parker.

I was born to write. Really, like a magical destiny there in my crib. My family has been publishing books since the mid 1800s (no website, Dad's orders ... sorry. We're old world). I do not, though, fall back entirely on nepotism! I have my Ph.D. in Comparative Literature from the University of California and beaucoup talent. Born and raised in Halifax, Nova Scotia, the finest province in all of Canada, Nouvelle Ecosse, to our beloved Quebecois friends, I am too trusting and innocent ... even gullible.

I fully expect a Mark Sutherland Simpson street there in Halifax some day! I live now in New York with my big golden Lab Rufus, who is my inspiration and my love. Welcome to my world of writing.
