## **ORDER**

Defendants have moved to dismiss on several grounds, including plaintiffs' failure to satisfy the arbitration requirement of the Foreign Sovereign Immunities Act, 28 U.S.C. § 1605(a)(7)(B)(i), and lack of personal jurisdiction and head of state immunity as to defendant Muammar Qadhafi (Libya's head of state). In their opposition to defendants' motion, filed on August 15, 2005, plaintiffs concede that they have not met the jurisdictional arbitration requirement of the FSIA¹ and agree to the dismissal of defendant Qadhafi.

Accordingly, it is this 6th day of September, 2005, hereby

**ORDERED** that defendants' motion to dismiss is **GRANTED** and this action is dismissed without prejudice.
