CHAIN OF COMMAND

Chief of Police Charles H. Ramsey will be in overall command of the department.

Executive Assistant Chief of Police Terrance Gainer will assist the Chief of Police and be responsible for all Operational Services Command.

The Assistant Chief in Command of the Command Information Center will be responsible for:

- Coordination of all activities outside of the sanitized IMF/World Bank Zone.
- Tracking of intelligence.
- Movement of personnel and equipment through the city.

Inside of the sanitized IMF/World Bank Zone the Incident Commander will be responsible for coordinating all activities with the Command Information Center.

Assistant Chief of Special Services Command, Alfred Broadbent will be in overall command of all activities and personnel in the sanitized areas. (23rd to 15th Streets, L Street to Constitution Avenue, N.W.)

ROC Chiefs will be in overall command of all activities and personnel outside of the sanitized area in their respective ROC's.

Any movement of personnel and or equipment shall be reported to CIC as soon as possible, but within 15 minutes of any such movements. The telephone number for the CIC is 727-9099.
