PROPOSED ORDER

Upon a reading of the motion of Scott L. Fenstermaker, Esq. seeking reconsideration of this Court's January 22, 2009 *sua sponte* order denying Petitioner's January 13, 2009 motion for miscellaneous relief to the extent that it denied Petitioner's motion for access to the legal mail system in place at Guantánamo Bay, Respondents' opposition thereto, and Mr. Fenstermaker's reply, the Court hereby
