ORDERED that Respondents' obligation to produce additional exculpatory evidence

pursuant to section I.D. of the Case Management Order, as amended, shall remain in effect during the stay. It is further

ORDERED that the Protective Order remains in effect during the stay. It is further ORDERED that either party may move the Court to lift the stay at any time and on any grounds provided the moving party gives the non-moving party written notice ten (10) days prior to the date of filing the motion. The parties waive the right to oppose any motion to lift the stay so long as written notice is given to the non-moving party ten (10) days prior to the date of filing

the motion. It is further

ORDERED that the parties shall file a joint status report on June 9, 2009, advising the
Court of any change in circumstances and, if circumstances have not changed, proposing
changes to the Case Management Order, as amended, and requesting a status conference.
