**SUBJECTIVE:**

Detainee was seen at his cell in Camp Echo. He reported that he no longer wished to take [REDACTED] because of concerns over his [REDACTED] and also because he was [REDACTED]. I then advised discontinuing [REDACTED] and following him without using [REDACTED] and he asked to be placed on an [REDACTED]. When I asked what the need for [REDACTED], given that he had just stated that he was getting a sufficient amount [REDACTED] he smiled and looked away before stating that [REDACTED]. Alternative [REDACTED] were discussed. He agreed to re-trying [REDACTED].  
Otherwise, the detainee reported doing well. His mood has been generally good, and he had no other complaints. He endorsed no thoughts of self-harm or harm to others. He was informed that [REDACTED] was available as needed if [REDACTED] continued, although this was primarily associated with [REDACTED].

**OBJECTIVE/MSE:**

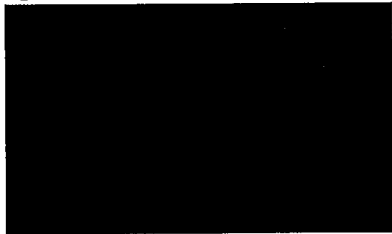
Detainee was interviewed in his cell at Camp Echo. He was dressed in tan and exhibited adequate hygiene. No unusual [REDACTED] were noted. Detainee made good eye contact except as noted above. He was cooperative during the interview. There was no current report of evidence [REDACTED]. Speech was normal in range, rate and intensity. Thought processes were linear, logical and goal directed. His mood was euthymic with a congruent affect. He denied current suicidal ideation, plan or intent, and denied HI insight-fair. Judgment and impulse control at this time not impaired. Cognition overall intact.
