[PROPOSED] ORDER RE COUNSEL VISIT SCHEDULED FOR OCTOBER 27, 2008

Petitioners have filed an emergency motion for order related to a counsel visit scheduled for October 27, 2008. Based on the grounds recited in the motion, and pursuant to this Court's management of the protective order in these cases, and for good cause shown, it is hereby

ORDERED:

1. The terms of this Order shall apply only to the counsel visit now scheduled for October 27, 2008 (the "Meeting"). Each party shall reserve all rights to address counsel-access issues by motion. Nothing in this order shall prejudice any such rights.
2. During the Meeting, the government shall permit counsel to meet petitioners jointly within Camp Iguana, and without separation by chain-link fence or otherwise.
3. Counsel may bring to the Meeting and leave with petitioners copies of all court filings and orders in this case (including any appeals therefrom) or in *Parhat v. Gates*, No. 06-1397 (D.C. Cir.), transcripts of all hearings therein, and all such materials in, as well as press accounts of, and published opinion pieces concerning proceedings in this case or the Appeals. All such materials shall be subject to a search for physical contraband before being admitted to Camp Iguana as otherwise provided in previous orders of this Court, but shall not otherwise be excluded. The government will permit the petitioners to retain these materials.

4. The Meeting shall be permitted to continue in Camp Iguana from 9 a.m. until 4:30 p.m. without interruption. Counsel shall be permitted to remain through the lunch hour.

5. During the meeting, counsel and petitioners shall be permitted to move freely within Camp Iguana, including in the huts available for meeting and the outside areas.

6. During the Meeting, no Petitioner shall be chained or otherwise confined, other than being within Camp Iguana. Those Uighur prisoners held at Camp Iguana who are not meeting with counsel shall not be confined or constrained by reason of counsel's visit other than being within Camp Iguana.
