**PROPOSED ORDER**

Upon a reading of the motion of Scott L. Fenstermaker, Esq. for an Order of this Court directing the Federal Defender of the District of Nevada (“Federal Defender”) to serve him with copies of all filings made by the Federal Defender on behalf of Petitioner herein, for the opportunity to file a consolidated reply to filings styled “Respondents’ Response to ‘Petitioner’s Response to the October 3, 2008 Order to Show Cause and Motion for Miscellaneous Relief,”” the Federal Defender’s “Response to ‘Petitioner’s Response to the October 3, 2008 Order to Show Cause and Motion for Miscellaneous Relief,”” and “Response (sic) the Court’s October 27, 2008 Order to Show Cause” and for an Order expanding the Local Rule 7(e) page limit for reply submissions from 25 to 40, and finding that good cause exists for such requests, the Court hereby

**ORDERS** that, until further notice, the Federal Defender is to serve copies of all of her filings in this matter on Mr. Fenstermaker at his office address of 300 Park Avenue, 17<sup>th</sup> Floor, New York, New York 10022;

**ORDERS** that Petitioner herein may file a reply to filings styled “Respondents’ Response to ‘Petitioner’s Response to the October 3, 2008 Order to Show Cause and Motion for Miscellaneous Relief,”” “Response to ‘Petitioner’s Response to the October 3, 2008 Order to

Show Cause and Motion for Miscellaneous Relief,” and “Response (sic) the Court’s October 27, 2008 Order to Show Cause,” within five days of proper service on Mr. Fenstermaker of the Federal Defender’s filings, and

**ORDERS** that the Local Rule 7(e) page limit for reply memoranda be expanded from 25 pages to 40 pages for the limited purpose of Petitioner’s consolidated reply.
