

(1) 25% of Defendant's disposable wages for each work week pay period; or

(2) the amount by which Defendant's disposable wages for each week exceed 30 times the prescribed federal minimum hourly wage in effect at the time the wages are payable (currently \$5.15). In the case of wages for any period other than a week, multiply

the current federal minimum hourly wage by 30, then multiply the resultant product by the number of full and/or partial weeks which are included in the pay period being considered.
