## **DECLARATION OF DR. THERESA DEISHER**

I, Dr. Theresa Deisher, declare as follows:

- 1. I am a plaintiff in this action, and I am over the age of eighteen and competent to testify. I am knowledgeable about the facts set forth herein and make this declaration in support of Plaintiffs' Motion for Preliminary Injunction.
- 2. I am an adult stem cell researcher specializing in adult stem cell therapies and regenerative medicine. I work exclusively with adult stem cells, and I do not conduct research on embryos or use embryonic stem cells.
- 3. I am the founder, managing member, and research and development director of AVM Biotechnology. I personally funded AVM Biotechnology, with the help of private donors.

These funds are limited, and additional private funding is scarce and difficult to obtain. In order to continue my research, and in order for AVM Biotechnology to achieve success, I must obtain funding from the National Institutes of Health ("NIH"). I am currently in the process of applying for NIH funding, and I will continue to seek funding for adult stem cell research in the future.

4. The National Institutes of Health Guidelines for Human Stem Cell Research will result in increased competition for the limited resources that are available to fund human stem cell research, threatening my ability to obtain federal funding for my adult stem cell research.
