## **ORDER ON REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION**

Plaintiff Warren Youmans filed suit seeking to reverse the decision of the Social Security Administration denying him Social Security Disability Benefits. On April 24, 2012, Magistrate Judge Kay entered a memorandum opinion denying Plaintiff's motion for a judgment of reversal and granting Defendant's motion for judgment on the pleadings. Shortly thereafter, this Court deemed the memorandum opinion to be a Report and Recommendation and stated that Plaintiff may file a written objection no later than July 20, 2012.<sup>1</sup> Plaintiff failed to file any objection.

After careful review, this Court adopts the well-reasoned analysis of Magistrate
