On April 1, 2013, the Court issued an Order directing Plaintiff to respond to the Motion by April 15 or risk the Court's deeming the matter conceded. <u>See</u> ECF No. 5. As Plaintiff has not done so, the Court will treat the Motion as conceded and dismiss the case without prejudice. <u>See</u> LCvR 7(b). A contemporaneous Order will so state.
