MEMORANDUM OPINION

This matter is before the Court on Respondents' Statement Why Writ of Mandamus Should Not Be Granted and Motion to Dismiss the Petition [ECF Nos. 10-11]. On June 23, 2014, the Court issued an Order advising the petitioner of his obligations under the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and the local rules of this Court to respond to the motion. Specifically, the Court warned petitioner that, if he failed to file an opposition to the motion by July 18, 2014, the motion would be treated as conceded.
