


determine whether the doctrine of *res judicata* applies. *Brown v. Califano*, 75 F.R.D. 497, 498 (D.D.C. 1977).

The complaint neither includes a statement regarding the Court's jurisdiction nor identifies the contract underlying plaintiff's breach of contract claim. It is impossible to discern which defendant has taken which action that has caused plaintiff to suffer the injuries for which he demands damages of "Three-Hundred Million Dollars." Compl. ¶ 6. Review of the exhibits attached to the complaint shed no light on the nature of plaintiff's claims.

As drafted, the complaint fails to comply with Rule 8(a) and therefore it will be dismissed. An Order consistent with this Memorandum Opinion is issued separately.
