security benefits. Plaintiff alleges only that he filed for benefits in 2011 and indicates that he has exhausted his administrative remedies. The complaint fails to identify a "final decision of the

Plaintiff is a District of Columbia resident suing the United States for the denial of social

Commissioner of Social Security" reviewable under 42 U.S.C. § 405(g). Rather than dismiss

this action, the Court will permit plaintiff time to amend the complaint to provide adequate

notice of a claim.

Accordingly, it is ordered that:

1. Plaintiff's motion to proceed in forma pauperis [Dkt. # 2] is GRANTED.

2. Within 30 days from the filing date of this Order, plaintiff shall file an amended

complaint that identifies the agency decision(s) forming the basis of this action. Plaintiff's

failure to comply within the time provided will result in dismissal of the case without prejudice.
