MEMORANDUM OPINION

This matter is before the Court on Defendant's Motion to Dismiss Plaintiff's Complaint and Opposition to Plaintiff's Motion for Temporary Restraining Order and Preliminary Injunction, Dkt. 5.¹ On October 6, 2015, the Court issued an Order advising Plaintiff of her obligations under the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and the local rules of this Court to respond to Defendant's motion, and specifically warned Plaintiff that, if she did not respond to the motion by November 6, 2015, the Court would treat the motion as conceded.
