4. I am a member in good standing and eligible to practice in each jurisdiction and court to which I have been admitted. I have never been disciplined by any bar.

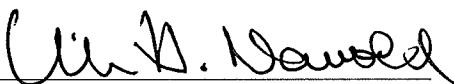
