

ORDER DISMISSING CASE

Plaintiff's Complaint was filed *pro se* in this Court on January 16, 2018. Pursuant to the Court Order dated January 29, 2018, the Court denied Plaintiff's IFP application. This Court also notified Plaintiff that if he failed to pay the \$400.000 filing fee within 30 days of the January 29, 2018 order, his Complaint would be dismissed without prejudice for failure to prosecute under Rule 41 of the Rules of the Court of Federal Claims.
