ORDER

On June 7, 2019, the court issued a show cause order in this matter. See ECF No. 11. Therein, the court directed pro se plaintiff to file a response to the court’s show cause order, on or before June 21, 2019, “explaining why this action should not be dismissed for failure to prosecute under RCFC 41(b).” *Id.* at 1. The court’s order further stated that “[d]ismissal pursuant to this rule ‘operates as an adjudication on the merits.’ If plaintiff fails to meet this deadline, this case will be dismissed.” *Id.* As of the filing of this order, the court has not received any filings from plaintiff.

Accordingly, pursuant to RCFC 41(b), the clerk’s office is direct to **ENTER** final judgment **DISMISSING** plaintiff’s complaint, **with prejudice**, for failure to prosecute.
