ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Plaintiff Charles B. Henry ("Plaintiff"), an Alaska state prisoner proceeding <u>prose</u>, ¹ filed a Complaint with this Court apparently seeking to submit an appeal to the Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit rather than a cause of action within this court's jurisdiction. <u>See</u> ECF No. 1 at 1.

Plaintiff's intended appeal appears to be related to an incarceration stemming from sexual abuse of a minor in 1990. See ECF No. 1 at 2-5. The Court of Federal Claims does not have appellate jurisdiction over criminal convictions.

Therefore, the Complaint is **DISMISSED** for lack of jurisdiction. The Clerk of the Court is instructed to enter judgment accordingly.

¹ Plaintiff also filed an application to proceed <u>in forma pauperis</u>. ECF No. 2. The Court **GRANTS** the Motion for the limited purpose of the jurisdictional inquiry.
