
Accordingly, it is now

ORDERED:


Counsel shall register for CM/ECF or notify the Clerk's Office of an error by contacting Deputy Clerk Kim Arnett in the Clerk's Office at (239) 461-2003 **on or before March 15, 2007**. If counsel fails to register by the March 15, 2007, deadline, counsel will be terminated as counsel of record **as of March 16, 2007**, and will not receive any further copies of pleadings and filings from the Court

until registration is accomplished and a Notice of Appearance is electronically filed.
