**ORDER**

This matter comes before the Court on Amended Partially Agreed Motion to Extend Deadlines in Scheduling Order (Doc. #36) filed on March 22, 2013. Plaintiff moves for an order extending the deadlines in the Case Management and Scheduling Order (Doc. #27) by 90 days.
