ORDER¹

This matter is before the Court on the Parties' Stipulation of Dismissal with Prejudice filed on July 30, 2015. ([Doc. #61](#)). [Rule 41\(a\)\(1\)\(A\) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure](#) allows a plaintiff to dismiss a case voluntarily without a court order. [Rule 41\(a\)\(1\)\(A\)](#) reads, in pertinent part, that

[s]ubject to Rules 23(e), 23.1, 23.2 and 66 and any applicable federal statute, the plaintiff may dismiss an action without a court order by filing: (i) A notice of dismissal before the opposing party serves either an answer or a motion for summary judgment; or (ii) A stipulation of dismissal signed by all parties who have appeared.

[Fed. R. Civ. P. 41\(a\)\(1\)\(A\)](#).

In this instance, the Parties stipulate to dismissal under [Rule 41\(a\)\(1\)\(A\)\(ii\)](#). ([Doc. #61](#)). Because all the Parties who have appeared have signed the Stipulation, the Court finds good cause to dismiss the case.

ORDERED:

- (1) The Parties' Stipulation of Dismissal with Prejudice ([Doc. #61](#)) is **GRANTED**.
- (2) This case is **DISMISSED with prejudice**.
- (3) The Clerk of the Court is **DIRECTED** to enter judgment accordingly, terminate any pending motions, and close the file.
