ORDER¹

This matter is before the Court on Plaintiff Provident Bank's Notice of Voluntary Dismissal Without Prejudice (<u>Doc. #14</u>) filed on March 26, 2015. <u>Rule 41(a)(1)(A) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure</u> allows a plaintiff to dismiss a case voluntarily without a court order. <u>Rule 41(a)(1)(A)</u> reads, in pertinent part, that

[s]ubject to Rules 23(e), 23.1, 23.2 and 66 and any applicable federal statute, the plaintiff may dismiss an action without a court order by filing: (i) A notice of dismissal before the opposing party serves either an answer or a motion for summary judgment; or (ii) A stipulation of dismissal signed by all parties who have appeared.

Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(1)(A).

In this instance, Plaintiff voluntarily dismisses the Complaint (<u>Doc. #1</u>) under <u>Rule</u> <u>41(a)(1)(A)(i)</u>. (<u>Doc. #14</u>). Defendants Joseph A. Borci and Rebecca A. Borci have not

filed an answer or a motion for summary judgment. The Court, therefore, dismisses the case without prejudice.

Accordingly, it is now

ORDERED:

- (1) Plaintiff Provident Bank's Notice of Voluntary Dismissal Without Prejudice (<u>Doc.</u> #14) is **GRANTED**.
- (2) The Clerk of the Court is **DIRECTED** to enter judgment accordingly, terminate any pending motions, and close the file.
