ORDER¹

This matter comes before the Court on Defendant Brandt England's Motion for Summary Judgment ([Doc. #44](#)) filed on November 9, 2015. The Court denies without prejudice Defendant's motion because it does not comply with the Court's procedure on a motion for summary judgment. Each motion for summary judgment must include a specifically captioned section titled, "Statement of Material Facts," that lists each material fact alleged not to be disputed in separate, numbered paragraphs. See [Letter to Counsel Regarding Updates to Policies and Procedures \(Oct. 14, 2015\)](#) (emphasis added).² In addition, each fact must be supported by a *pinpoint* citation to the specific part of the record relied upon to support that fact. *Id.* Because Defendant's motion does not list

each fact alleged to be disputed in separate, numbered paragraphs, the Court denies his motion without prejudice.

Accordingly, it is now

ORDERED:

Defendant Brandt England's Motion for Summary Judgment ([Doc. #44](#)) is **DENIED without prejudice**. Defendant may file an amended motion for summary judgment that complies with the Court's procedures on or before **November 24, 2015**. Plaintiff Dyck-O'Neal, Inc. may file a response thereto within **fourteen (14) days** of service of Defendant's amended motion for summary judgment.
