ORDER¹

This matter comes before the Court on Magistrate Judge Carol Mirando's Report and Recommendation on Defendant JITCO Group Limited's ("JITCO") Motion for Attorneys' Fees and Costs (<u>Doc. #144</u>), the Parties' Joint Notice of Settlement (<u>Doc. #145</u>), and the Parties' Joint Stipulation of Voluntary Withdrawal with Prejudice of JITCO's Motion for Attorneys' Fees and Costs (<u>Doc. #146</u>).

On February 24, 2015, JITCO filed a Motion for Attorneys' Fees and Costs (<u>Doc.</u> #115), to which Plaintiff United States responded on April 1, 2015 (<u>Doc. #122</u>). Thereafter, Magistrate Judge Carol Mirando issued a Report and Recommendation, recommending that the Motion be granted in part and denied in part (<u>Doc. #144</u>). Now, the Parties have alerted the Court that they jointly stipulate to the withdrawal with prejudice of JITCO's Motion on the basis of a settlement agreement. (<u>Doc. #146</u>). The

Parties' Joint Stipulation (Doc. #146).

Accordingly, it is now

ORDERED:

1. Defendant JITCO Group Limited's Motion for Attorneys' Fees and Costs

(Doc. #115) and Magistrate Judge Carol Mirando's Report and

Recommendation (Doc. #144) are **TERMINATED** as moot.

2. This action is **DISMISSED without prejudice** subject to the right of any

Party, within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order, October 16, 2015,

to submit a stipulated form of final judgment or request an extension of time,

should they so choose, or for any Party to move to reopen the action, upon

a showing of good cause. See Local Rule 3.08(b). After the sixty (60) day

period, however, without further order, this dismissal shall be deemed with

prejudice.

3. The Clerk is directed to terminate any previously scheduled deadlines and

administratively close the case pending further order.
