## ORDER<sup>1</sup>

This matter comes before the Court on the Plaintiff, Tania Luchetta's Notice of Voluntary Dismissal with Prejudice (<u>Doc. #8</u>) filed on August 28, 2015. <u>Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a)(1)(A)</u>, allows a plaintiff to dismiss a case without a court order. The Rule reads in pertinent part:

Subject to Rules 23(e), 23.1, 23.2 and 66 and any applicable federal statute, the plaintiff may dismiss an action without a court order by filing:

A notice of dismissal before the opposing party serves either an answer or a motion for summary judgment; or

A stipulation of dismissal signed by all parties who have appeared.

Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(1)(A).
