ORDER¹

This matter comes before the Court on *sua sponte* review of the file. On June 17, 2017, the Court granted *pro se* Plaintiff Nickolas Kovtuschenko's Motion to Dismiss to Defendants Charlotte County, Charlotte County Code Enforcement. ([Doc. 8](#)). It also directed him to file a written notice by June 30, 2017, that states whether he was also dismissing this case against the other named defendants, or if he intended to proceed against them. ([Doc. 8](#)). Plaintiff has not responded to the Court's Order, and the time to do so has expired. He thus has evidenced a lack of interest in prosecuting the remainder of this case. See [M.D. Fla.
