**ORDER**

This matter is before the Court upon periodic review. Plaintiff filed his Complaint on February 22, 2013. (Doc. 1). On April 23, 2013, the Commissioner filed an answer to the Complaint. (Doc. 14). Pursuant to the Court's Scheduling Order (Doc. 16), and the Court's prior Order granting Plaintiff an extension of time (Doc. 23), Plaintiff's memorandum in support of his position was due by September 26, 2013.
