## ORDER

This cause is before the Court on Plaintiff's Amended Motion for Partial Summary Judgment (Doc. 112) and Defendant's Motion and Supporting Brief for Summary Judgment on Behalf of Retrieval-Masters Creditors Bureau, Inc.
