ORDER

This cause comes before the Court on the Complaint (Doc. No. 1) filed by Plaintiff on October 17, 2013, appealing the final decision of the Commissioner of Social Security (the Commissioner) denying her claim for benefits.

4. The Clerk of Court is directed to enter judgment in accordance with this order and thereafter close the file.
