ORDER

THIS CAUSE is before the Court on Plaintiff's Motion (Doc. 2), seeking leave to proceed *in forma pauperis*. United States Magistrate Judge Karla R. of this case without further notice. Plaintiff may also file a renewed motion to proceed *in forma pauperis*.
