ORDER


This case is before the Court on the Complaint (Doc. 1, filed November 10, 2016) filed by Plaintiff seeking review of the final decision of the Commissioner of Social Security ("Commissioner") denying his claim for Disability Insurance Benefits The United States Magistrate Judge has submitted a report recommending that the final decision be affirmed.
