Dear Mr. Bodle:

This letter is to serve you notice that the above mentioned permit is hereby being revoked.

This action is in accordance with Section 102-3-2 of the Standard Building Code 1985 Edition (enclosed), and the Affidavit you submitted with your application for the above referenced permit (enclosed).

Regarding Section 102-3-2 of the Standard Building Code during numerous reinspections of the electric service wiring to your mobile home, you have been in violation with the provisions of the code and incapable of correcting the violations.

Regarding the Affidavit for homeowner permit you submitted with your application, you are in violation of item 3(e). During the last two electrical inspections, you requested my Field Inspection Supervisor, William T. Scarff and Electrical Inspector, Ralph Swenson to inspect your unit. On August 5 and 7, 1991, you were directing my inspectors to troubleshoot your electrical system with their equipment. It was evident you lacked the basic knowledge, skills and equipment to make the necessary corrections and installation.


It also became evident upon checking the interior of your mobile home that the original wiring in the unit had been altered and added to from the initial factory wiring. This would require that the entire electrical system to be exposed for rough and final electric inspections, and be properly permitted by a licensed electrical contractor.
