ORDER

Before the court is the **Unopposed Motion to Substitute Attorneys of Record** (Dkt. 84) filed by William Guerrant, Esq. of Hill, Ward & Henderson, P.A. on behalf of Defendants Costar Realty Information, Inc. and Costar Group, Inc. Movants request an order permitting William Sauers, Esq. and Sanya Kerksiek, Esq. of the law firm Crowell & Moring LLP to withdraw their representation of Defendants and substituting Matthew Oppenheim, Esq. as Defendants' counsel.
