ORDER

¹ This amount represents statutory damages in the amount of \$1,000.00, reasonable attorneys' fees (which this Court determines to be five (5) hours at a rate of \$300.00 per hour) in the amount of \$1,500.00, and costs in the amount of \$400.00.

3. The Clerk is directed to terminate any pending motions and CLOSE this file.
