ORDER

This cause comes before the Court for consideration of Plaintiff's complaint seeking review of the decision of the Commissioner of the Social Security Administration. (Doc. No. 1). This complaint was considered by the United States Magistrate Judge, pursuant to a specific order of referral. Magistrate Judge McCoun has filed his report recommending that the Commissioner's decision be reversed. (Doc. No. 16). All parties were furnished copies of the Report and Recommendation and were afforded the opportunity to file objections pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1). No such objections were filed. Upon consideration of the Report and Recommendation, and upon this Court's independent examination of the file, it is determined that the Report and Recommendation should be adopted.

- (3) The Clerk is directed to enter judgment in favor of Plaintiff and to close the case.
