ORDER

This cause comes before the Court upon the Report and Recommendation filed by Magistrate Judge Thomas B. McCoun III on December 5, 2014 (Doc. 25). - (3) The Settlement is approved, as it constitutes a fair and reasonable resolution of disputed claims.
- (4) The settlement award and attorneys' fees and costs shall be disbursed promptly.
- (5) This action is DISMISSED with prejudice.
- (6) The Clerk is directed to terminate all pending motions and close this file.
