ORDER

THIS CAUSE comes before the Court upon Defendant L. Scott Roger's Motion to Dismiss Count VII of Plaintiff's Complaint (Dkt. #5). Upon review of Defendant's motion, the Court concludes that it should be granted for the reasons stated therein. Specifically, as Defendant points out, Count VII is a purported cause of action for recovery of attorney's fees with no substantive allegations supporting a breach of the underlying agreements. Such a claim is inappropriate because the law does not recognize an independent claim for attorney's fees. As such, Count VII is dismissed and construed as a request for attorney's fees under the underlying causes of action. Accordingly, it is

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that:

 Defendant L. Scott Roger's Motion to Dismiss Count VII of Plaintiff's Complaint (Dkt. #5) is GRANTED. 2. Count VII of Plaintiff's Complaint is dismissed and construed as a request for attorney's fees under the relevant causes of action.
