**ORDER**

This cause comes before the Court upon the Report and Recommendation filed by Magistrate Judge Julie S. Sneed on January 30, 2018 (Doc. 89). In the Report and Recommendation, Magistrate Judge Sneed recommends that Defendant's Motion to Tax Costs (Dkt. 84) be DENIED without prejudice and with leave to re-file within thirty days of the entry of a mandate by the Court of Appeals on Plaintiff's pending appeal. All parties were furnished copies of the Report and Recommendation and were afforded the opportunity to file objections pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1). No such objections were filed.
