**ORDER**

This matter comes before the Court in consideration of Defendant Master Deputy Raymond Rembert's Motion to Dismiss Plaintiff's Amended Complaint (Doc. # 10), filed on February 18, 2016, which seeks dismissal of the Amended Complaint in its entirety.
