ACCORDINGLY, it is therefore, **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED**:

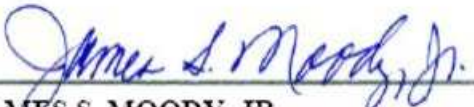
