<u>ORDER</u>

This cause comes before the Court upon the Report and Recommendation filed by Magistrate Judge Julie S. Sneed on October 29, 2020 (Doc. 248). (3) Plaintiff's Motion to Stay Consideration of Defendants' Motion for Fees (Doc. 242) is **DENIED as moot**.
