ORDER

ON AUGUST 2, 2017, this Court entered an Order directing Plaintiff to appear personally at a status conference scheduled for August 23, 2017. (Dkt. 10). The Order expressly stated: “FAILURE OF PLAINTIFF TO APPEAR AT SAID CONFERENCE . . . SHALL RESULT IN THE DISMISSAL OF THIS CAUSE” (Dkt. 10). The Court finds, based on Plaintiff’s willful failure to comply with this Order, that lesser sanctions will not suffice. *Pierce v. City of Miami*, 176 F. App’x 12, 14 (11th Cir. 2006). Accordingly, this case is **DISMISSED** without prejudice. All pending motions are **DENIED** as moot. The clerk is directed to **CLOSE** this case.
