ORDER

This cause comes before the Court upon the Report and Recommendation filed by Magistrate Judge Anthony E. Porcelli on March 30, 2022 (Doc. 46). In the Report and Recommendation, Magistrate Judge Porcelli recommends that: 1) The Unopposed Motion for Award of Attorney Fees Pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 406(b) (Doc. 44) be granted; 2) Plaintiff's counsel be awarded attorney's fees in the amount of \$28,045.75 under 42 U.S.C. § 406(b); and 3) Plaintiff's counsel be directed to reimburse to Plaintiff the \$13,312.50 in fees paid under the EAJA. - (2) The Unopposed Motion for Award of Attorney Fees Pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 406(b) (Doc. 44) is GRANTED.
- (3) Plaintiff's counsel is awarded attorney's fees in the amount of \$28,045.75 under 42 U.S.C. § 406(b).
- (4) Plaintiff's counsel shall reimburse Plaintiff \$13,312.50 in fees paid under the EAJA.
